Five Little Speckled Frogs - INSTRUCTIONS

MATERIALS:

- Scissors
- Glue
- White, heavy duty printer/copier paper (preferably cardstock paper for the most durability)
- Adhesive laminating sheets or a lamination machine
- Small, adhesive round hook and loop (Velcro) fasteners
- Large Wooden Craft Stick (Popsicle stick)
- Five Speckled Frog printable

INSTRUCTIONS:

STEP 1: Print the attached page with images on heavy weight printer paper (preferably cardstock).

STEP 2: Laminate the page (both sides).

STEP 3: Cut out each image.

STEP 4: Attach the soft (fabric) side of the round Velcro fastener to the back of each frog

STEP 5: Lay each frog side by side on top of the log (for spacing purposes) then attach the rough side of the Velcro fastener to the log underneath each frog. You can also put the Velcro together on the back of the frog then stick to the log that way while you're spacing them out. Press down hard to make sure everything adheres completely.

STEP 6: Glue one end of the craft stick to the back of the log. Let Dry. Once dry, this will be the handle for holding up the log with the frogs attached.

STEP 7: Time to Play! Attach the frogs to the log in numerical order. When ready to sing the song, sit on the floor facing your child. Place the pool on the ground in front of you. Sing the song and when you get to the verse that says "one jumped into the pool", have your child remove Frog #1 and place it into the pool. Then finish the last line of the song and repeat with the remaining frogs.

This would also be great on a felt board!

Extra Learning Tip: In the last line of the song, when you say how many frogs are left, have your child count them out loud and point to each one.
